Local Rules - High Course

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
 - Beyond any hedge, fence or wall bordering the course.
 - On any part of the low course.
 - On the driving range or practice putting green.
 - When playing 17th and 18th holes on or beyond the 10th fairway.
 - On or over the car park/road when playing the 1st and 3rd holes.
- STONES AND BUNKERS (RULE 24-1)**
Stones in the bunkers are movable obstructions, and may be removed without penalty.
- STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2)**
If a staked or stayered tree interferes with a player's stance or his/hers intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped without penalty in accordance to Rule 24-2b.
- POWER CABLES (Rule 20-5)**
If a player hits an overhead power line, the shot MUST be disregarded, and replayed from the original place without penalty.
- SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)**
All pop up sprinkler heads, travelling sprinklers and their hoses are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2b.
- LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)**
All lakes and ditches marked with red stakes are lateral water hazards.
- WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)**
All ditches marked with yellow stakes are water hazards. Bridges crossing ditches are an integral part of the water hazard.
- CHIPPING AREA (Rule 33-2c)**
The area within the white lines situated beyond 9th and 18th greens is a designated practice chipping area. This area is to be treated as Ground Under Repair. It is not an integral part of the course.
- EMBEDDED BALL**
A ball embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

To ensure everyone enjoys their game of golf to the full please observe the following: It is the duty of every golfer to keep pace with the game in front (and not just ahead of those behind).
Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers.
Please keep trolleys and bags off tees and green aprons.
Every player must have their own bag of clubs. Sharing a set of clubs is not permitted.

INSURANCE & SAFETY
Everyone is advised to ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. In the interests of safety, please ensure those in front of you are out of range before playing a shot.
